SUBJECT: FELLOWSHIP CONFERMENT

We wish to inform all corporate members who are eligible and have satisfied the requirements below for the Fellowship of the Institution to kindly apply.

Application for the conferment of "Fellow of NIGE" for this year shall close on Thursday, October 31, 2024.

GUIDELINES FOR FELLOWSHIP CONFERMENT:

The conferment of "Fellow" of the Institution shall either be by invitation of the Executive Council of the Institution or by normal application by a member to the Executive Secretary, NIGE who shall in turn refer such application to the Board of Fellows of the Institution. Each fellowship candidate shall complete an Application form to be issued by the Secretariat or obtained and filled online via NIGE's website: <https://nige.org.ng/>

• FELLOWSHIP BY NORMAL APPLICATION.

A person applying for the Fellowship of the Institution shall have not less than fifteen (15 years) experience in the practice of Geotechnical Engineering. In addition, he/she shall meet the following conditions:-

- i) Must be a Corporate Member of the Institution for a minimum of 10 years with active participation at AGMs and meetings at Chapter level.
- ii) Have rendered valuable and selfless service to the Institution over a period of time.
- iii) Should be versed and experienced in the field of Geotechnical engineering
- iv) Obtain a letter from his/her chapter testifying to his/her active participation at the Chapter level or from the Executive General Secretary where there is no Chapter existing in his town or State of operation.
- v) Obtain letters from two Fellows of the Institution testifying to his/her competence of being conferred with the Fellowship of the Institution.

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- vi) Must pay NIGE Fellowship and Processing fee of Three hundred thousand naira (N300,000) only into NIGE's Account No. 0030059758 - Union Bank or 200USD into NIGE's Dollar Account No. 0030184551 domiciled in Union Bank for members outside Nigeria after approval of the application form by the board of fellows.

• **FELLOWSHIP BY INVITATION**

A person to be invited for Fellowship of the Institution via this route shall have not less than 20 years experience in the practice of Geotechnical Engineering and must have been a Corporate member OF NIGE for at least 5years.

In addition, he/she shall meet condition (i) and at least any of the conditions (ii) to (iv) stated below:

- I. Pay a mandatory invitation fee of One hundred and fifty thousand naira (N150,000). This is in addition to administrative charges of processing/materials fees of Three hundred thousand naira (N300,000) only into NIGE's Account No. 0030059758. Candidates outside Nigeria should pay a total sum of 400USD into NIGE's Dollar Account No. 0030184551.
- II. Submit a dissertation containing valuable statistics on his Geotechnical Engineering practice in this Country or
- III. Submit a dissertation or thesis on a particular Geotechnical Engineering case study in Nigeria for which he or she participated or
- IV. Submit a dissertation adjudged by The Board of Fellows Committee to be a worthwhile contribution to Geotechnical Engineering knowledge in the Country
